### The images of God and the cry for life

How do the images of God in the scripture used to bridge the chasm between human and God Almighty? Can human beings ever comprehend God who is up aloof? God is a spirit all perfect and unlimited by space of time while humans are earthly, flesh and blood bound. Paul therefore reminds us in 1Tim 6:15-16, that there are no way our minds can grasp this Devine being.

However the good news is that God made himself known to us in different ways. He has inspired the Bible writers to present Him in concrete images. Quite often the images of God in the Bible are portrayed with human images and emotions such as love, delight, patience, anger, jealousy, disappointment. He is also portrayed in human roles like husband, mother, king, parent, warrior, judge, doctor, teacher, shepherd, farmer, potter, party host to name a few. He is sometimes pictured in terms of human made implements and structures; he is like a cup, a shield, a dwelling place, a walled city. He is also embodied in earthquake, storm and fire. Furthermore he is portrayed as the sun, wild animal, bird and rock.

Sometimes certain passages present God in a single image-he is shepherd in Ps.23; Is 40:11, a father in the parable of a prodigal son Luke 15:11-32, a mother in Is 66:13, parent in Heb 11. (New century version). There are times we may question why all these varieties of images of God? It is because no single image could do justice to define God. Truly various images of God contain the perfect truth of God.

The image of God as shepherd embodies God's tender care, king suggests his majesty and exalted status, lion signifies God's might, rock signifies God's strength and mother carries the meaning of compassionate. Thankfully we can assure our self that God inspired the Bible writers to use different images to let every individual understand God very clearly while preventing us to adopt single image which might forbid us in knowing the greatness of God fully.

For instance if I address God as my heavenly parent, friend or my shield my understanding of God never end's there I surely do know that he is immortal, infinite, all wise, all powerful, all perfect infact my human tongue cannot define or describe God because he is everything to me yes everything to me! Amazingly God used different images for Himself for he knows that different people read the Bible with different personalities and background, different needs, desires, circumstances and situations.

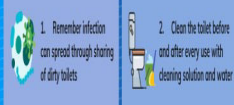

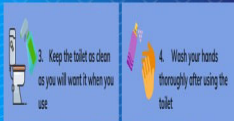

### Toilet Etiquette



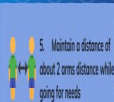
1. Remember infection can spread through sharing of dirty toilets

# COVID-19 MYTH BUSTERS

Methanol, ethanol, and bleach are poisons. Drinking them can lead to disability and death. Methanol, ethanol and bleach are sometimes used in cleaning products to kill the virus on surfaces – however you should never drink them. They will not kill the virus in your body and they will harm your internal organs.

To protect yourself against COVID-19, disinfect objects and surfaces, especially the ones you touch regularly. You can use diluted bleach or alcohol for that. Make sure you clean your hands frequently and thoroughly and avoid touching your eyes, mouth and nose.

To date, there is no evidence or information to suggest that the COVID-19 virus is transmitted through houseflies.

The virus that causes COVID-19 spreads primarily through droplets generated when an infected person coughs, sneezes or speaks. You can also become infected by touching a contaminated surface and then touching your eyes, nose or mouth before washing your hands. To protect yourself, keep at least 1-metre distance from others and disinfect frequently-touched surfaces. Clean your hands thoroughly and often and avoid touching your eyes, mouth and nose.

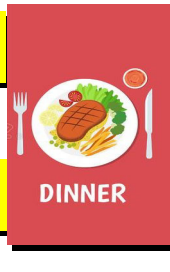

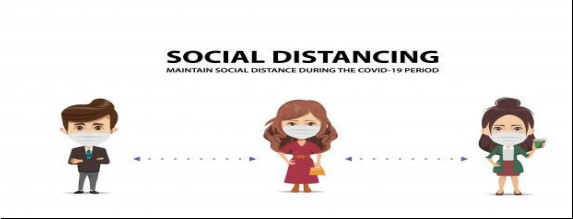
