### Christ is our Hope

Lately, humans have developed so much dependency and over confidence in our abilities, especially due to enormous technological advancement in many areas of life. This has resulted in making science and technology more realistic than God, and it manifests in many ways we deal with different issues in life. Humans could've never thought that science and technology would fail us someday. But sadly, it has exactly happened today, as the world is caught in surprise by the 'Pandemic' called 'COVID-19' where Science and Technology hasn't been successful to drive away the disease from this world. And this where we need something and someone beyond science, i.e., the intervention of the 'Higher Being'. The world can be healed and made whole again only through the intervention of the One who created it, and it is 'God'.

When we look in **Deuteronomy 29:5**, we find that, though the Israelites were walking through the wilderness for forty years their shoes and clothes did not wear out, and their feet too didn't swell. 

- 5 FEEL



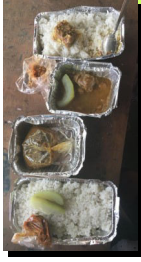

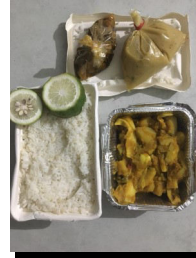
